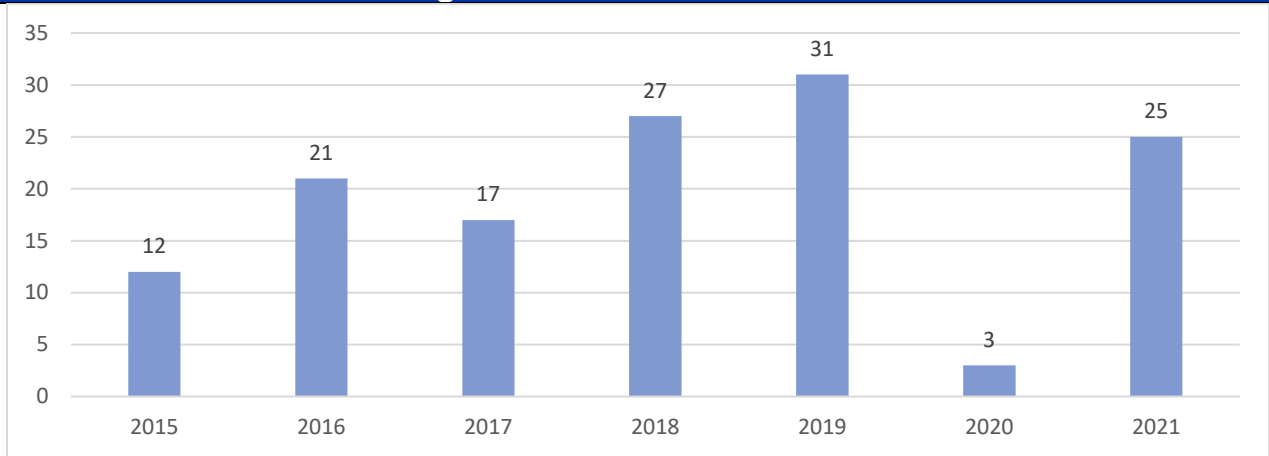


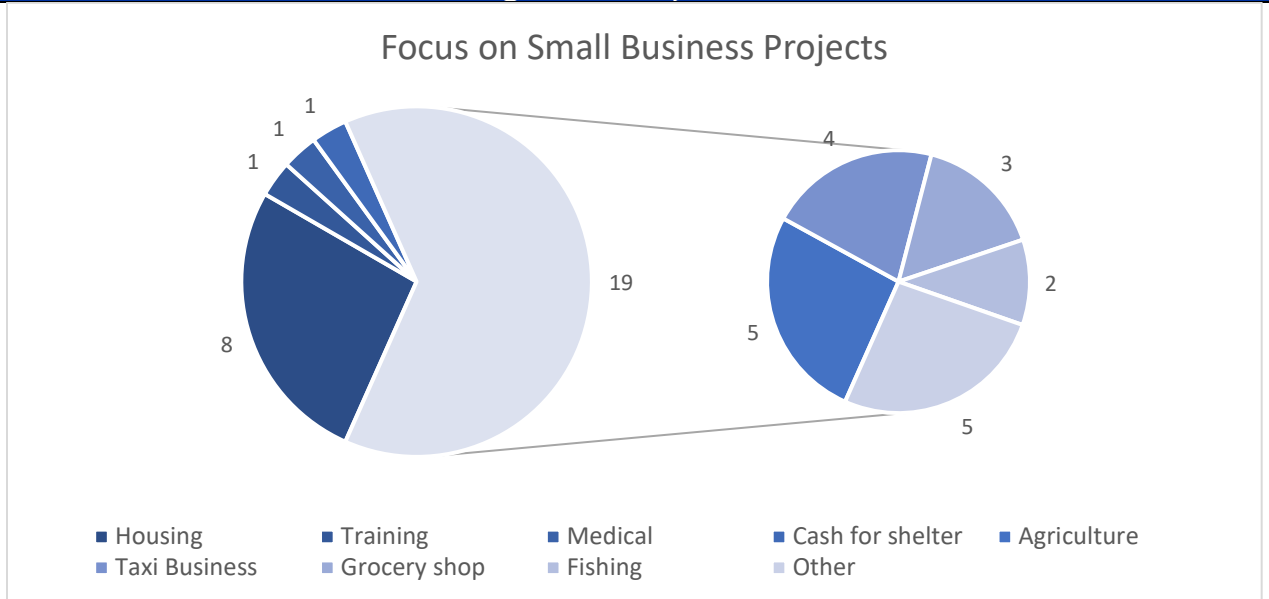
Reintegration Assistance – Flat Funding 2021 – Sri Lanka

- **Implementation support for 25 reintegration projects** in 2021 (for a total of USD 94'540), **19 male beneficiaries** and **7 female beneficiaries**, 1 child
- **Return operations for 10 cases** (7 men and 3 women, no children)
- IOM Sri Lanka was supported through a **Swiss flat funding** of USD 37,039 in 2021
- **3 Business Development Training** were conducted in 2021 with 22 returnees.

Business Training Results

- While business training activities could not be implemented in 2020 due to the Covid19 pandemic, a total of **6 beneficiaries** having returned from Switzerland took part in **Business Development Training** in 2021 alongside 16 returnees from other countries.
- Generally, the number of migrants returning to Sri Lanka from Switzerland in 2021 was higher than in 2020 (Covid-19 related restrictions) and reached again a considerable number.
- Unused funds from 2021 will be used to implement business training activities in 2021. All beneficiaries who returned in 2021 will also have access to these activities.

- The graphic on the right showcases the **geographic distribution** of Swiss reintegration mandates in Sri Lanka.
- 48% of all beneficiaries in 2021 returned to **Jaffna**, 20% to **Batticaloa**, 8% to Trincomalee and 16% to other districts
- The activities include individual reintegration projects in the fields of accommodation, transport services, shops or agriculture/fishing.
